COVID-19 RULES FOR PLAY

To access the course, a player must.

Be an active playing member

Not have been out of the country in the previous 14 days

Not be in self-isolation and not required to cocoon

Not be displaying COVID-19 symptoms

Have a pre-reserved tee time

Be a fully paid up member or have made arrangements to pay

Booking & Arrival

Tee bookings will be available each day from 8:00am (7:30am on Saturdays) until 7:00pm.

Play outside these time is strictly forbidden to enable the club to fulfil possible track and trace requirements if required by the NHS or Public Health England.

Tee bookings can only be made in advance via the BRS Golf Online System If unable to obtain a time, it is acceptable to request a tee reservation by calling only the club on 01744 885808.

Booking a tee time in advance is compulsory – via website, app, or phone to the clubhouse.

All tee bookings are from the first tee only and for 18 hole rounds.

Members can book to play alone, or with one other person from a different household, who must be a member who has paid, has an arrangement to pay or is a guest of that member.

The maximum number of players per tee time is 2.

When restrictions are eased, visitors will be encouraged to book and pre-pay online

We require all players to provide a phone number and email address to enable contact tracing.

All golfers will be made aware of our measures prior to their visit.

Golf equipment should be cleaned before a player leaves home.

Golfers should travel to the club alone, or with a member of the same household

Golfers MUST park in the main car parking area.

Ample car parking spaces are available to ensure social distancing. If possible, do not park next to your playing partner.

Arrival at the course no more than 10 minutes prior to reserved tee time.

Observe the two-metre social distancing always and resist the temptation to mingle.

Locker rooms are closed.

Arrange golf attire and change footwear at the car – whilst maintaining minimum social distancing.

Report straight to the Clubhouse upon arrival.

Check-in is compulsory.

Check-in Protocol

Mandatory check in at the Clubhouse for all golfers.

Two-metre queue markers at clubhouse entry point.

One golfer only in the clubhouse at any one time. Do not enter unless it is empty.

Card payment preferred, but cash will be accepted at the till

Clubhouse Facilities

Clubhouse Access is limited to the Check in.

Players must provide their own golf clubs, hire sets will not be available

Players to arrive in golf attire and change shoes at the car

Locker rooms and toilets are closed with the exception of one toilet in the clubhouse

Due to a current shortage of hand sanitisers, please bring your own

All benches are not to be touched or used

Buggy hire is available, but for single players only unless both are from the same household and proof of this will be required i.e. driving licence.

On the tee

Groups are restricted to a maximum of 2 players, at 10-minute intervals

All practice areas are closed

Arrive at the 1st tee no more than 5 minutes prior to the reserved tee time

Any player(s) not following directions will be asked to leave the course

Tee off times strictly observed to ensure minimum 10-minute group spacing

On the Course

Physical distancing observed throughout, particularly on tees and greens

Rubbish bins are not to be used, any rubbish should be taken home

Ball washers are not to be used

Bunker rakes removed, players to smooth sand with feet prior to shot

Flagsticks to remain in the hole and must not be touched

Hole cups converted with foam inserts for simple, contact-free ball retrieval

Once a hole is completed, the group in front must have exited the tee box before players can progress to the next hole

Ring any call through bells with your club

Do not double back to play again if a ball is lost, unplayable, or in a penalty area

Equipment, food, and drink must not be exchanged between players

Players must not pick up another player's equipment or golf ball

Players must refrain from handshakes and high fives

All course benches are not to be used

When the round is finished, return to the car park by the pathway to the left of the 18th green and leave the club premises immediately.

Do not wait for other groups for socialising

Getting Home Safely

Post-round, players must return straight to their cars

Ensure clubs and equipment is cleaned thoroughly after use

Players requested to log their round in the HSE COVID-19 contact tracing app when it becomes live

Players must call or email the golf club with any post-round health issues or COVID-19 related queries, at the earliest possible opportunity
